

HLTAID004 Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting

COURSE OVERVIEW

- This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults. It applies to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies.
- This unit of competency may contribute towards approved first aid, asthma and anaphylaxis training under the Education and Care Services National Law, and the Education and Care Services National Regulations (2011).
- The course is fully accredited nationally recognised training.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- There are no formal educational entry requirements, but participants must pass a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test prior to training.
- You will need to perform a required duration of continued CPR on a practice manikin so we ask that you inform training staff if you have a problem with your back or knees. While we can cater for this to some extent, remember you are practicing and being assessed on a skill that could be performed in any condition anywhere.
- You must be at least 14 years of age to attend the training.
- We ask that you wear clothing that is comfortable and not too restrictive to allow you to comfortably perform CPR and other practical activities.
- You must wear enclosed footwear at all times while training with us.

DURATION & STRUCTURE

The course is conducted face to face in a classroom-based learning environment over 7 hours. You can attend the training at our training centre in Fairfield. You will also be required to complete a pre-course learning workbook and assessment prior to attending your practical training day. These will be provided to you electronically on enrolment.

You will conduct a range of simulated activities, work in small groups and you will need to complete a theory component online prior to attending the practical day to be deemed competent. Proof of completion of the theory is required before we can confirm attendance at one of our practical sessions.

POTENTIAL JOB ROLES

This program has a very broad application in all sectors of the community and all workplaces and industry. It does not directly lead to a defined employment outcome in its own right, but is a component of a set of skills that can lead to employment or assist with maintaining conditions of employment.

For example, all teachers and childcare workers and educators need to maintain currency, as do many other workplaces First Aid and WHS positions.

This course is a single Unit of Competency in HLTAID004 Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting. You will learn the key skills required to competently respond to emergency situations commonly found in an education and care setting.

Topics Covered:

WHS Legislative requirements
Duty of Care
Identify and respond to an emergency situation
Assess and minimise hazards to self, others and the casualty
Assess the need to perform CPR
Assess the casualty and check for a response
Recovery position
Caring for an unconscious casualty
Sending for help and notifying emergency services
Perform CPR in line with ARC guidelines
Obtaining consent from casualty or caregiver or medical practitioner
Reporting details to supervisor and emergency services
Completing relevant workplace documentation
Reporting details of incidents involving babies and children to parents or caregivers
Recognising the possible psychological impacts on self, other rescuers and children
Talking with children about their emotions and responses to events
